



17 Year Old Consent Form

Recreational & Educational Tours, Inc.

Please read these rules carefully. Student and parents of student that are minors must sign:

1. All minors must have a signed consent by parents both authorizing their participation in the trip and the guidelines for minors. Also, the emergency consent and medical form must be filled out and signed. These forms can be downloaded and printed from the Mentor High School webpage. Click on "FORMS"
2. All minors will have a curfew at the hotel. They will be permitted to visit other rooms until that curfew time. They will have to check in with the security guard in the hall to report what room they will be visiting and return to their rooms at curfew. A room check will be conducted at curfew of all rooms regardless of age. Those 18 years old will not be permitted to visit any rooms with minors after curfew. If a room group consists of both 17 and 18 year olds, all in that room must adhere to the guidelines of minors.
3. We must have a list of birth dates of all participants upon registration. ID's will be checked when boarding bus from Mentor High School. This will be matched to the registration list. The room list will be marked according to rooms with all 18 year olds, all 17 year olds and mixed rooms.
4. Rooms with all minors or mixed rooms will be kept separated at the hotel. Same hall just separated.
5. Rooms can not be mixed gender, even for those 18.
 - * There will be security on duty from arrival at hotel until breakfast to ensure the hotel guidelines are followed.
6. During the days at Put-in-Bay and Cedar Point all students will have at least two check-in times. A check-in does not have to be in person, but instead a photo taken in front of an identifiable location with names of students texted with the photo.
7. Smoking or consumption of alcohol or use of any illegal substance at any time will result in immediate dismissal from trip. If a minor is involved, the parents will be notified and must make immediate arrangements to get the student home. If anyone 18 is involved, it will be reported to local police. Any action that would potentially impact the safety of the student or other students will be handled in the same way.
8. Students' supervision will be on a limited basis during daytime activities. Chaperones will remain on site at all times and have an available cell phone for assistance, but will not be directly with students at all times. Students may not leave Cedar Point, Kalahari or Put-in-Bay at any time for any reason.
